## HANG FLYERS & CREATE POSTS

## ATTRACT YOUR PET BACK HOME

Place worn clothing, bedding, strong smelling food outside, & leave a window/door open



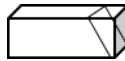
## TELL EVERYONE YOU CAN!

Including vets, shelters, friends, family, neighbors, businesses, & social media



## CHECK SHELTERS *IN PERSON* & OFTEN

Calling isn't enough. Your pet may look different now.



## SET A HUMANE TRAP

This is good when pets are too scared to approach safely.



## REPEAT! REPEAT! REPEAT!
